 - 1.5.2 Cultivating connections with community groups, organizations, and potential funding sources
 - 1.5.3 Assisting with major Capital campaigns, as they arise.

Special Committees

- 1.6 The Board may establish or disband permanent Special Committees as may be deemed necessary from time to time, membership of such Committees and terms of reference being approved by the Board at the time of appointment.
